

Mrs. Senk started her FAA career as an Operations Inspector at the Milwaukee Flight Standards District Office. From there, she moved to Texas to begin working with the FAA Flight Program Division, serving as the Service Center Manager and Acting Standardization Branch Manager. In 2012 she was selected as a Supervisory Aviation Safety Inspector for a new office established in the FAA, the Part 142 Certificate Management Office.
